Basis and Timing of Offers of Admission

RMC's application process is independent from that of the Ontario Universities' Application Centre. Changes to the Ontario university admission offer date agreement will not affect RMC's admission process. Applicants will be informed of the decision of the Selection Board no later than mid-May. RMC uses a separate application form. Applicants may indicate up to three degree programs but are accepted into either the Science/Engineering Program or the Arts Program. Science/Engineering applicants will be considered for an alternate offer to Arts.
